

Articulation Agreement

between

Southeastern University and Pathway

July 29, 2020

Southeastern University (SEU) in Lakeland, Florida, hereby enters into an articulation agreement with Pathway, the ministerial training program associated with Trinity Life Center of Sacramento, California, to accept some credits from its program for transfer into SEU's Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Arts degrees.


The general parameters for the agreement are for a three to one ratio (three valid Pathway credits with a minimum 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale for every one SEU credit granted by transfer). All Pathway courses, credits, and faculty credentials must be vetted by SEU staff for approval. Assuming all courses and professors are approved for transfer credits, a maximum of 28 credit hours of the 120 or more total credit hours needed for the SEU bachelor's degree could be granted. Approved Pathway transfer credits will be transcribed by SEU following the successful completion of at least 15 semester hours at SEU with a GPA of 2.0 or higher.

Additionally, 54 credit hours are required to complete the standard general educational courses for all the undergraduate degrees at SEU and must be completed either through Southeastern University or another accredited college. Per accreditation requirements, all degree recipients must complete a minimum of 25% of their degree program through the degree-granting institution. Therefore, a minimum of 30 hours must be completed directly through SEU in order to earn the bachelor's degree.

Southeastern University retains the right to approve or deny acceptance of individual students into its degree programs based on its published admission criteria. Southeastern University also retains the right to approve or deny specific substitutions of Pathway courses for SEU courses.
